We continue to make progress with on the Family History Task Force Action Plan as much of our work aligns with the Public Health Cancer Genomics Program (grant funded by the CDC via CDPHE). These efforts include:

- 1. bi-directional reporting (where patients at increased risk for inheriting a cancer-causing genetic mutation are referred for genetic risk assessment),
- 2. educational efforts the citizens of Colorado and their health-care provider on who needs genetic-risk assessment (in the final stages of developing a website which addresses these topics—will be linked to the CCC page when ready) and
- 3. policy impact (we are finalizing a scan to assess what procedures/ tests insurance companies cover with regard to genetic testing and counseling, and follow-up procedures/surgery/screening; next steps include efforts to address the gaps identified in the scan).

Lung Cancer Task Force Update

- Tobacco Control: Colorado Senate Bill 273 is trying to lower the cost of tobacco for tobacco distributors. Senators Williams and Hill have introduced the bill. The bill, if passed, would negatively affect tobacco revenues and impact programs funded by Amendment 35. It was agreed that the Lung Cancer Task Force should work closely with Bob Doyle from the American Lung Association and do what we can to oppose the bill.
- Tobacco Control: Bob Doyle is writing a proposal for funding for a tobacco tax education campaign in Colorado. Such statewide education will be required if we are to consider a tobacco tax initiative for the 2018 or 2020 ballot. Anyone interested in working on this effort, please contact Bob Doyle at BDoyle@lungs.org
- Overview of All Payers Claims Database: Members are in the process of a preliminary
 analysis of the database to see if these codes are being used with any frequency (Lung
 Cancer Screening CT, Shared Decision Making and Smoking Cessation Counseling). At our last
 meeting Bill indicated he would do a preliminary analysis of the database to see if. The
 APCD could be a very useful resource for our Task Force in finding out the prevalence of lung
 cancer in Colorado, variations in geographic distribution and population groups, utilization of
 Lung Cancer Screening CT, costs, etc.
- **Slide set for provider education**: We're currently finalizing a slide set to have available to share with providers.
